

On motion of Mr. Street,

*Resolved*, That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, praying that His Excellency will be pleased to appoint three or more fit persons as Commissioners to revise, and if necessary, make a new Ordinance of Fees in the Supreme Court, on the Crown Plea and Exchequer side thereof; and also, to take into consideration the propriety of introducing into the Supreme Court in this Province the new Rules of Pleading in Civil Actions, at present in force in England, so far as the same may be applicable to this Country, and to report the result of their doings to His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, for the purpose of being laid before the Legislative Council and House of Assembly at the next Session of the Legislature,
