

Mr. Street, from the Committee appointed to wait upon His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, with an Address of the **House** of the **27th** day of February last, praying that His Excellency would be pleased to appoint Commissioners to revise the Ordinance of Fees, and if necessary to frame a new Fee Table in the Supreme Court of this Province ; and also to take into consideration the propriety of introducing the new Rules of Pleading, at present in force in the Court of Queen's Bench in England, so far as the same may be applicable to this Country, and to report the result of their doings to His Excellency, to be laid before the Legislature at the next Session, reported -That the Committee had attended thereto, and that His Excellency was pleased to say, that he should have great pleasure in complying with the wishes of the House in that respect.
