And besides the care hereby directed of raising and maintaining of Forts & Fortifications, as above mentioned; you are likewise, in case the Frontier of our Province of New York be at any time invaded by an Enemy, to call upon our Province of the Massachusetts Bay, to make good in Men (or Money in lieu thereof) their Quota of Assistance, according to the Repartition herewith sent you; Assuring them, that in case of the like Invasion of the Province of the Massachusetts Bay, they will be mutually assisted from New York.

And you are withall to signify to them, according to their behaviour in this occasion, they will remember themselves, to our Royal Grace & Favour, I so bid you heartily farewell, Given at our Court, ^{at Ham.} the 1st Day of January 1710, in the twelfth year of our Reign.
