20. Wrote mama and Sister West enclosed to her pr Danniels.  
Cobb arrived from Minis; received many letters by him.
21. Arrived McGee's schooner from Minis.
22. Wrote my sister and enclosed to Mr. Green pr Jaggert, who sailed the same day.
23. The Indians fired upon our cattle.
24. Wrote Mr. Delancy and Watts and Capt Scott and Dungum, also Mr. McKenzie, which he is to forward to him to Cape Fear
30. Rhodes arrived. Rec'd letters from C. Scott. The Indians attacked our wood party and wounded 3 men, but were soon obliged to retire.
6. At 12 o.c. sailed from Boston for Halifax; went into Marblehead for a pilote.
8. Sailed from Marblehead wind S. W. by 3 o.c. P. M. rainy and foggy. Stood for Cape Ann Harbour; arrived at 5 o.c.
9. Fine weather and all breeze at S. W. this morning made sail at 3 o.c. A M.
12. 4 o.c. cloudy, made the land but could not know it.
14. Arrived at Oles Head and lay there till the 17th at 6 o.c. P. M. made sail and arrived at Halifax Sunday 18th just at 7 o.c. at night.
23. Wrote by Collins to my sister & J & J & E & Mr. West, Capt Pierce, Mamma and bro John.
28. Wrote to Bro Joan for tobacco by Capt Battermin. Memo to write to Mrs West for a paper of patches.
