then & there in our said Court to answer unto Henry Hingman of
Bridgewater in the County of Plymouth Gentlman in a plea of
assault on the 19th day of November 1598 by him of that
date for value received from him the Plaintiff to pay him the
sum of seven pounds nine shillings and four pence lawfull
money upon Demand with Lawfull Interest & his said
the Defendant requested has not paid said sum nor
yet to do it

To the Damage of the said Henry (as he saith) the sum of nine Pounds which
shall then & there be made to appear with other due damages & have you there
this writ with your doings therein witness Nicholas Lecher Esq. at Plymouth
this 19th Day of March in the 32d year of our Reign and Dominion
