New York 22nd September 1783³⁻²

Sir,

Having learnt that Governor Parr is in great want of a vessel for the service of the province, I beg You will inform him that an armed Schooner, named the Greyhound, the property of Government, and completely fitted, shall be sent to him, to be considered as entirely at his disposal. - She is already paid to the 24th August, and You will please to order her to be paid to 24th October 1783, inclusive, after which I make no doubt the province will readily defray every expence attending her; from that period she can no longer be paid by us.
