St. Augustine 24th Sept: 1783.

Sir,

As I imagine there will be a final Settlement with the S.^t Car. Royalists, King's Car. Rangers, and S.^t Car. Volunteers, on their arrival at Nova Scotia, I have inclosed (in three packets) the original Muster & Copies of the last Abstracts of these Corps, for Muster at this place: which with their Accounts, are paid to the 24th of Oct: inclusive. The attained Brig: Genl. M^r Arthur's have to attend for the Settlement of my Subsistence, & come to Nova Scotia early in the Spring: but delay, may not affect my Grant of it. But I have wrote Samuel Campbell Esquire on it, and have taken the liberty to refer him to any Official matters that may be requisite in establishing my right: and I beg you will do me the favor to give the necessary Orders thereon.
