

Return of a Survey of a Tract of Land, laid out for Edward Winslow Esq. situated on the Southwest side of St. John's River, beginning at a Birch Tree marked E.W. eight chains above Piquionk Creek, the lower Boundary of Block N. 4, and running South 5° West 90 Chains, thence South 45° East 42 Chains, thence North 5° East 90 Chains, thence North 45° East to a Birch Tree marked E.W. standing on the Bank of the River St. John's - thence the course of the River to the first mentioned Boundary, containing 1000 Acres, or thereabouts.
