

By this Excellency Thomas Carleton
Brigadier General Commanding His
Majesty's Forces in the Province of New Brunswick,
do. do. do.

You are hereby authorized and required
forthwith to receive from Samuel Blake Esquire
Commissary of Stores of War &c, for New Brunswick
the sum of Twentyone pounds fifteen shillings
and seven pence half penny Sterling, Dollars
at four shilling and eight pence. Being the
amount of two thousand and ninetyone
Rations of Provisions at two pence half penny
each, issued by him to the Staff and Departments
in the Province of New Brunswick at the
ports of Fredericton, Fort Howe and Fort
Cumberland, between the 25th day of September
and the 24th day of December 1780, inclusive
agreeable to the Abstract herunto annexed
which has not yet been regularly accounted
for as appears by the Settlement of this
Provision amounts for that period. And
You will appropriate the same to the
payment indiscriminately of the Contingent
and Extraordinary Expenses of His Majesty's
Forces under my Command. And for so doing
this shall be your sufficient Warrant.
