Sir,

I have the honor to signify to you His Majesty's pleasure, that you cause the 16th and 20th Regiments of Foot under your command to be held in readiness to proceed to Jamaica, upon your receiving a requisition for two Regiments from the Governor of Jamaica, or from Major General Williamson who commands in Chief His Majesty's Troops in that Island.

In case it should be determined in Jamaica to apply to you for this additional Force, either Ships of War, or other proper Vessels will be sent from thence to Halifax, for the purpose of conveying the said two Regiments to their destination.
