

James Brown of West Isles in the County of Charlotte and Province of New Brunswick, Carpenter, aged Sixty five years or thereabouts, deposes and saith that he has lived in the Paspamaguaddy Settlement ever since the year One thousand seven hundred and Sixty nine. —

That he together with Jeremiah Frost, erected a Hut near to where the public Landing in Saint Andrews now is, which was the first Building of any kind ever put up by any English subject, that he knows of, at or near that place. —

Jeremiah Frost of S. Stephens in the County and Province aforesaid, Farmer, aged Forty eight years or thereabouts, deposes and saith that he has lived in the said Settlement ever since the year One thousand seven hundred and Seventy. —

That he together with the above named James Brown, erected the Hut above mentioned. —

And these Deponents do, each of them, further say that, having carefully perused and examined the foregoing Deposition of Alexander Hodges, all and singular the several Matters and Things therein contained, from that part describing Paspamaguaddy Bay to the Close of the said Deposition, to their certain Knowledge, are in fact and substantially true, as therein they are set forth, such part thereof as relates to M. Corvan and Nicoll, Col. "Louis" Hyattine and M. Boyd, only excepted, to which, not being knowing, they further depose not. —
