I detain my wife of all the light Infantry part of my family - of stood ready with a boat to run like a lusty fellow for the Highlands. The ridge where the buildings stand was complicated insulated - I saw all my cattle & even my sheep & hogs - my fences, of course went to the devil.

The namesake of Godson, whom you have condescended to enquire about is deserving of the name he bears - ~~he~~ ^{is} a very handsome - all bodied fellow - very ambitious of particularly tenacious of the title of Governor which is invariably bestowed upon him.

What will become of him gall the rest of us God knows - After so many escape of perplexities, I don't despair of saving them from passing - but half a score is a very doubtful allowance - The elder one has after immense sufferings work himself upon the L. Deck of the Bellona - He was 19 months before the mast before he was rated - He is perfectly in his element & says he never was so happy in his life.
