

To request your Excellency will
be pleased to permit me to draw the fuel &c.
that was due to me on my leaving residence in
October last: or if your Excellency will have the
goodness to order me to be paid the amount due
for the same, shall be equally satisfied.
I have to inform to request I may be allowed
to draw all wood from the Office the same as
the Officer of the St. R. Percible an allowance
that live in town. I have to state in my town
& of course to be used by me. I hope your
Excellency will deem my request not unreasonable
under the variety of inconveniences & extra
expenses I have already experienced for the
want of fuel &c.
The Barrack regulations direct fuel &c.
to be issued to Sergeants Major & Quarter Master &
Sergeants of all Corps. I leave to solicit
your Excellency in behalf of them of this
description in the Corps under my command
who are so useful to the public service.
The Quarter Master has likewise charge of
public stores & is entitled to half a room in
two capacities. The Sergeants Major & Quarter Master
Sergeants of the company of Artillery at Halifax
have always received this allowance. I hope
your Excellency will agree with me, that
there should be no distinction in allowance
granted to situation which has no reference
to the individual that fills them. In every
point of view I must think the men of
that description in my Company are every
way deserving of such. I presume to
recommend them to your Excellency
consideration for the established allowance
of fuel &c. the same as in other Corps.
