 -tely settled and till they are likewise
 informed that some settlement

with respect to the boundaries

between the Province of New Brunswick

of the Province of Canada has been
 made & approved, and as their

Lordships observe that in his Majesty's
 said additional instruction of 1790

the following reason is assigned, as

one of the reasons for the said point -

"That great advantage will arise from
 the further negotiations to be entered
 in the disposal of the said Lands" Their
 Lordships are pleased to direct that
 enquiry be made at the Office of the
 Secretary
