Saint Andrews 29th January 1803 -

Having by this conveyance written you fully on the State of the Probate Business in this County, I have only to observe in addition, that several Applications having lately been made to the Governor and Council for the Appointment of Commissioners to ascertain the Claims upon insolvent Estates, it may be necessary for me to suggest to you, that although they are dated at the different parishes where the deceased persons formerly resided, or where the Administrators at present have their residence, it will still be necessary that the Commissioners to be appointed should be persons in the neighborhood of Saint Andrews as most of the Claimants are in this Quarter - and fit persons perhaps could not be selected for the purpose, unless in Saint Stephen, which may be an exception to the general Rule - and as the Subjects of their Appointment is within your immediate Department, I presume I shall not be considered as intrusive in mentioning that Donald M^r Donald, Donald M^r Lockton and John Campbell, in Saint Andrews - and Peter M^r Callum, Robinson
