Then Richmond a small settlement where resides a Mr. Pritchard.

Capt Marshall has a Shallop & sent his recruits to Bay of Verte from thence they cross to Cumberland & from Cumberland in a vessel to St. John.

Robine is a Jersey man has a store at Capron Jack & Perry. from Perry he is going to go by water to Quebec in the month of June. ab^t 300 miles from Perry to Quebec.

Mr. recommends that he stays 3 or 4 weeks at Miramichi. until the ice will allow — which will be early in May. and go in canoes to Carleton where he, & cross to Carleton & Perry which he, & make head. 2nd & which are the most likely to recruit.

Recruit what you can at Miramichi & then go on. They can't come recruiting from Canada so soon.
