I have the Honor to inclose you a Return of the Soldiers of the different Regiments in this Garrison who have been Invalided by a Board of Surgeons.

I have sent One hundred of them by His Majesty's Ship Torbay Commanded by Captain Leslie, and the Remainder in a Mast Ship called the Favourite. Francis Ellis Master.

The whole of them have Received Two Months pay in Advance from the 24th August instant, and are committed to the care of The Honorable Captain Murray of the 2^d Battalion of the 84th Regiment, who had obtained Six Months leave of Absence from Major General Paterson (my Predecessor in this Command) to go to Europe, on his own private affairs.
