Forbay and Favourite; — which Sum so stopped, You will on Your Arrival in London, pay to the Agents of the different Regiments; and the Balances remaining in your hands, after such Deduction, you will pay to the Men respectively, on their Landing in England.

And you will by the first opportunity, make a Report of their Arrival to the Secretary at War, and forward the inclosed Letter.

in the County of Halifax on the fifteenth day
of August in the Twenty third Year of the Reign
of Our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the Grace of God of
Great Britain &c. and in the Year of our Lord One thousand
seven hundred and eighty three. Pursuant to Commission
from His Excellency John Parr Esq. Captain General and Go-
vernour in Chief in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova
Scotia to be bearing date the fourteenth day of August instant,
