The order of the 7<sup>th</sup> of August inst. explicitly forbids all persons whatever from cutting Timber or taking Materials from off the Lands recommended by the Engineer to be reserved for Public Purposes, and it is my intention that this Order shall be carried into execution in its fullest extent. Should the Inhabitants trespass in any degree on the Land thus reserved, I am to request that you would immediately exhibit a complaint in writing to the Civil Magistrates, who I presume will prosecute all such Delinquents to effect.

If convenient opportunities offer for New York, you will (upon any emergent occasion) make your Report immediately to Head Quarters, taking care to forward to me exact Copies of all such Reports by the first conveyance to this place.
