Wednesday Nov 14. Recd. Oats Apples & Turnips
 from sundry people - Cloudy - Wind all
 N. but moderate - looks like a change of Wea.
 - then -

Thursday Nov 15. Recd some apples - got about
 wood - people ashore cutting it up - got up
 top of masts & rigging - Wind Nly but moderate
 Snow - flights at times - still disagreeable wea.
 - then -

Saturday Nov. 17. Yesterday went down to Anne
 polis Town. for a Pilot expect him up tomorrow
 - wea - Weather fair - small Winds. at abt 6
 Sunday Nov 18 - Came down to Town having
 been up the River 38 days - Wind fresh at NW
 with plenty of Rain.

Monday Nov 19 Went up to Round Hill to get
 some flour & beef - for weh I must send up

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the Boat Tomorrow - Wind Wly moderate
 weather fair -

Tuesday Nov. 20 Got down 2 of 1 beef. & 1. 2 -
 flour from Round Hill - Wind NW - fresh
 weather Cloudy - cool.

Wednesday Nov. 21. Bending Sails - setting up
 rigging - mending Caboose - & making felt for
 sea - Shipped 2 men - myself ashore all day
 finishing my business - - did 133 \$ flour to Mr.
 Sinclair to bake for me & a bush. wheat meal to
 Mr Withertake for same purpose - Wind
 Nly small - weather Cloudy - & sometimes Shine
 - Wrote Mr Hazzen S John's - sent him acc. 1. 18 -
 desiring him to remit it to Hlfap -

Thursday Nov 22 - Blown hard all day so that
 we could do nothing - Wind S.W. - snow rain
 & hail - towards evening more moderate -

Friday Nov. 23 - Blown very hard all day & WNW
 with snow at times - have not seen Mate nor man to day
 the Weather keeps them on board - now towards evening
 the Wind abates something -
