very glad to see each other

Thursday 11. Located 40 Yaggers on 10 Town  
Lots in C & D. Par's — partly surveyed. Shal-  
= Spear's Courtney's &c Grant — The Brewster's have  
= ered me from finishing — in the Evening  
went on board Watson's brig — spent the Evening  
there —

Friday 12. Laid out the Grant to the two  
Shakespears. three Courtney's — Lynch. Lowndes  
Cochain — & one to spare — Staked off 3 house  
lots in the north for 3 officers of 82 — & began  
survey of the water at its South End of the Town  
— Lyman sett out for Annapolis in a Boat  
with 2 men — This is 4th attempt — poor fellow I hope  
he'll get thro'

Saturday 13. Located 8 persons on North R.  
continued the Survey round the Cove — —

13 — wrote the Governor — respecting the  
expected arrival of 400 families from  
York in about 3 weeks — requesting his  
directions about locating them — whether  
— at its back or end of the Town — Took  
no Copy — could not — was too tired & Sleepy —  
Sunday 14 Recd. a Letter from the Governor — W.  
Morris — Geo Allan & Arth Gold Esq. — and the  
Governor's

Monday 15 Laid out Capt William  
Hargrave's Water lot — bounded as per Sur-  
vey book — wrote Ch<sup>r</sup> Morris Esq. & Bill  
now all my letters are answered but Geo  
Allan's

Tuesday 16 Located 16 person on 2. D & R  
north division

Wednesday 17 Located 6 persons in  
2 & P. South —
