Sunday 20 - A proper N East Storm with plenty of Rain - at home all day - not very Comfortable -

Monday 20 - (all the days of this Month wrong dated from Friday 4th 3. which is wrong)
Sent M^r Tully to Pilot's Town to lay off house lots for five persons - myself at home all day - too windy to be able to do any thing at the Water Lots ~~where~~ is the matter I wish to be by to finish -

Tuesday 21 went up the River with Lower Shakespeare Caspell & Pendergrass layed ^{more} 2. 500 acre Lots. which make 6 on the Western side the River - That Company are to have 4 more on the ~~the~~ Eastern Side - to begin above Mess^r Robinson's Grant - The Courtneys take the 3 next Lots to Shakespeare on the Western Side -

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Wednesday Oct^r. 22 Arrived this morning from my Survey for Shakespeare & Co having lodged in the wood all night -

Thursday 23. Planning the Survey of the six 500 acre Lots to Shakespeare & Co. - in Town all day - a very severe gale at S. E. Stay'd in Town all night - several arrivals from New York -

Friday 24 M^r Tully running Series in Paris Division for disbanded Soldiers - 4 blocks

This ~~last~~ Survey of the two last 500 acre Lots is not very accurate the sides of the Riverway so overflowed that in some places the distance was estimated only - ... gave M^r Walter a Letter to forward to H^l to the Governor

Saturday 25 at home till 6 in the evening made up tickets for 66 persons for house lots -
