Sunday 26 - a day of writing Letters to
Hly^p till dinner - dined in Town - home
at ^{dark} to a lonesome Solitary Tabernacle -
wrote to Governor Ch^r Morris Esq. - Wmth H^y
Allan - - sent in my Sep months acc^t -
Monday. 27 Located 70 persons in Penn^a
Division on part of L. M. - & all N O P Q
got a boat & men to go to Morrow with
W^m Mason to Survey the N W Arm -

Tuesday 28 Wrote W^m Morris - principally
a Letter of Opinion - wrote the Governor
respecting M^r Hinney & Cameron who have
set down upon ungranted Lands - at home
all day - weather rainy - moderate

Wednesday 29 - Busy all the morning
with People enquiring for Lots Lands &c

W^m Tully surveying Lines for four Blocks
for 4th 23. 42. & some Straglers of ~~the same~~
other Corps - W^m Mason up the N W Arm
surveying the Tongue of Land between
both Branches -

Thursday 30 - W^m Tully out this morning
with 4 Parties clearing ground for the 23. 42
& a few others - but the rain put them off from
4 business very soon - a wet rainy afternoon
& evening - W^m Lyman arrived from Hly^p

Friday 31. - Rain & wet all day till near Sun-
set. - However W^m Tully has been in the wood,
some part of 4 time - myself at home all day
preparing ^{together} to draw for 43 Town Lots tomorrow -
of 4th 42 - 9. 76th. 5. of 23. 28 in all 43.

Saturday Nov 1 Located 43 Soldiers mentioned
yesterday - morning fair middle day rainy -
squally till late then fair turning to cold -
