Wednesday 26 — Yesterday lay'd out 100  
acres for Potts & Craig between Bow-  
Wood & the 50 acre Lots — to day con-  
-ing on Gov. Wentworth —

Thursday 27. <sup>Probate Court. am</sup> with Gov. W. <sup>to day</sup>  
dined with <sup>him</sup> at G. Th. —

Friday 28. with Gov. W. over the  
River up to it Upper Saw Mill —  
return'd about 4 from —

Saturday 29. Began to run the Lines  
round the reserved ground to day  
but put off by the rain — over it was  
side — P.m. making out certificate  
Sunday 30 — making out certificate  
dinner time — —

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Wednesday ~~Thursday~~ 2<sup>nd</sup> with Lawson running the  
line of the Reserved Lands on it  
West side the River — broke off  
about noon by rain —

Thursday 3 sent 3 plans to the S. Gen.
