Began at the Point formed by the confluence
of the main S West Branch of the Meirimack

Thence run S. 15.° 30' E. ^{20 ch. of 4 rods.} on the main Branch
to a Pine on the upland marked on
in front. with red Chalks S 74° 30' W. 100 ch. on
north side H. M^c L. Lean on the South side
R. M^c Donald - From this Pine ran S 15.

10 ch. to a large Flat Rock lying on the
