

Miramichi August 1785

Field notes & observations on a Survey of land
to J^{no} W Leam - Roderick McDonald -
McMillan & James Donald -

Began at a Point formed by the little S West
the main River - Thence ran

S 15° 30' E 40 Ch. To a Spruce marked 10th side
S 27° 30' E. 16 Chs. **IML**. on 5th side **RM**. ^{ch}

Red Chalks - NB. 40 of these ch
were run on Thursday the 11th Inst. - But that Survey
was erroneous from my not having first Surveyed
the little S West but taking its course of it upon trace
I did not then allow sufficient front to W Leam

S. 7° - E. 3. Ch. to a maple marked 10th side

RM. the 5th side **AMM**. red chalk

S. 7° E. 10 Ch. to a Small Birch marked 10th side

S 16° 30' W 9 -

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on Survey -

S 46° W. 8 Ch.

S 71° W. 39 - to a large Pine about 1 Ch.

from the Water from this pine Donald's line
runs into the Woods S 70° W 15 Ch. then N 20° W 25.50 Ch.
to McMillan's line - marked
this Pine **ID** red Chalks -

3rd Payman chain bearer sworn -

The intersecting Lines which connect both sides the
River from Watson's 10th east corner to the mouth
of Indian Brook N 16° W. ^{dist. 6 Ch.} Thence ran a line S 53° W
5 Ch. then Indian Brook bore N 15° E. W Leam's
Point S 35° W - at the mouth of Indian Brook

W Leam's Point bore S 28° 30' W - W Leam's P.
from Watson's N.E. corner dist. 27. Ch.

The wood along the River the extent of the above
Lines Spruce Pine Maple Birch ^{Elm} Butternut
the land skirted with meadow generally 1 1/2 Ch
wide the two last lines a very high rocky Pre
cipice with old Pines on it about 2 or 3 Ch in from
the meadow -
