

Meirimachi August 1785

on Survey

Saturday 27th went from home up the Little  
I West - & laid off a piece of for Mr. Payne  
as follows viz.

Began at a Cedar tree on the side of the  
land, <sup>+ by side of a small run of water</sup> being Mr. McLean's western boundary  
marked with red Chalk on its east side. I  
on west side I.B. thence ran

N. 84° W. 29. Ch. to a Spruce marked I.B.  
large Rock in front in the water's edge  
a small cavity on the top of it

Sunday 28. returned home about Sun set.

Wednesday 31. Squire Wilson sat out for P.  
via Salmon River & the Grand

Friday 2. The morning foggy <sup>till about 10</sup> for the  
fog I've seen in the place - followed by  
overcast. Sky & calm - but pleasant -

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Sunday 4th Left my Lodgings at Squire  
Wilson's & came to Mr. Deslauriers  
at 10/ a week

Thursday 22. Drew the plans of the Lots layed out  
to Capt. McLean. James Donald & Mr.  
Watson - sent the last his plan. & ad-  
vised him that I had drawn on him for  
my fee 40/ payable to Capt. McLean of  
Shelburne.

Saturday 24 This day administered the State Oaths  
to Robt. Reed Esq. Coroner. & the oath of  
office - & He signed the Declaration

Wednesday 28 Left home - embarked on board Chappel  
for Bay of verte arrived there on Sa-  
turday 1<sup>st</sup> Oct. went to Cumberland  
that afternoon lodged at Allan's - on Sun-  
day 4<sup>th</sup> 2 embarked on board Capt. Ray  
for St. John & arrived there Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup>
