Foggy all the morning, on
clearing away a little discover
two sail. The Charlotte Prescott
& Seplic gave chase. The Carleton
follows. 1 o'clock. The Seplic gave over
the chase & informs us that
the ship in sight is a Flag
of France. on which we all
make sail for the Restoration.

a very thick Fog prevented our
coming up with the Restoration
till 5 o'clock P.M. at 7 came to
anchor at Holmes, 1st Hole.
