The Governor has received a letter from Gov. Hancock, communicating a resolve of Congress, that it appears from surveys which have been taken that the Easternmost river in the Bay of Papamaguddy is the true River St. Croix alluded to in the Treaty of Peace; &

and requesting that he would order those persons who have encroached on the territory of the States to retire peaceably within the limits of this Province.

This letter has been communicated to the General, and I suppose will occasion a fresh requisition for Troops. — Though it is not now in His Excellency's district — so I suppose the matter will be settled on your side the Bay.
