Thursday 11th Unpleasant Weather, Men clearing for potatoes.

12th Old Rose calved. Rec^d Letters from M^r. Leonard, Otatch

13th Sowed ^{1st from barn} 2 beds Carrots, 2 d^o. Beets, 2 d^o. Parsnips, 2 d^o. Onions, Also 1 d^o. Beets. - Tiled the Court. Mored.

Sunday 14th Weather still continues cold. L^r. M^r. Leonard.

15th Working among the drift stuff. Rthkest arriv^d with a raft of Tals. 1 Row pear, 2 d^o. potatoes.

16th Kelly helping J Bay &c. planted a few potatoes. In corn en^d. plowing in rear of barn. trim^d. apple trees.

17th Kelly plowing behind the barn. Day's boys drift stuff.

18th Sowed Green peas, Bush & Pol beans in the Garden. Mored. Kelly sowed 2 kinds of peas in the field. Blue & white.

19th Sowed 2 bushels oats also 1¹/₂ d^o. wheat by Barn. Shear^d 11 Ewes 1 yearling Lam. alter^d 3 Lambs turn^d. all out & 1 pot Ewe - Lamb.

20th Kelly & Jennins burning on ~~Mount Welden~~ ^{Mount Welden} plowing &c. rec^d 1 Black Jug Vinegar & 1 d^o. Rum by M^r. Pickard. Mrs. Jennins all this week.

Sunday 21st M^r. Gosselyns first month ends & wages p^d.

22nd Kelly sowed 2 bushels Wheat behind the House. 1 d^o. Oats. (Hilmaris.)

23rd Got up 270 of Pickard's Tals. M^r. F. Rainsford is to take the remainder & to return the same number to me. Sowed peck Timothy seed.

24th Scott (Shoemaker) began to work. Kelly moving drift stuff.

25th Moving drift stuff all day. Kelly & Jennins ^{at 1 o'clock a piece} Kelly plowing corn. bot 1 Salmon, 2/6. of Howard. 12th Veal & Clare 7/6. Weather Cold & unpleasant. Jennins absent at Garder's. Let Johnstone &c. here. Bot Est. pot & baskets 2. a dollar for the whole.

Sunday 28th Cool blustering Weather. Miller here.

29th Rec^d Letters from Bernard Cobbe Esq. Col Lutwyche 2. M^r. Leonard &c. Kelly in the Corn field.

30. 31. Planting Corn & potatoes - orchard, K & J, ^{intention}

June 1st Young Rose calv^d. bot 2 pigs of Connor. 5 each.

2. 3. Planting potatoes in orchard. finish 3. (Dorqhu.) Jennins 4 days this week.

Sunday 4th Cold & Wet. p^d Scott 15/. M^r. Hazen here.

5th Plowing on Mount Welden 2 yoke Oxen. bot 5th butter of M^r. Nally & 6th. - 15th d^o. J. Pickard.

6th Finish^d plowing & began harrowing Mount Welden.

7th Sowed half a bushel of wheat and began planting potatoes on the mound supposed to be 92 or 93 bushels. and on Saturday the 10th finish^d

Sunday 11th very ill with the gout packets from Sir John Wentworth on Friday

16th Sowed Swedish turnips.

17th Sowed Bush & Bent

24th Kelly absent all the last week.
