- 16th 17th Sunday. bot 1 bush. Rye of Clements 6/6.
- 18th 19th Sowed 2 bush. Buckwheat. Young Black Heifer.
- 24th Old Rose. 22nd finish^d my 6 days on the Road. Slept 3 Kelly. 23rd Kelly & Locke for themselves 1 day each.
- 25th 26th Locke & Kelly hoeing potatoes.
- 25th July Hoeing. making Bridge & clearing for turnips.
- 24th began moving & ended 9th Aug.
