work to this day.2^d Rain in Even^g.Sunday. Pleasant. Catharine went to M^c Clark's.

3^d 4th. Hired John Chante for one year from
this day. and agreed with him in the
presence of Thomas Costin - that he is
well of faithfully to obey all my law-
ful commands, & to perform all &
every kind of work within doors &
without which may be required of
him - That he is particularly to attend
to the horses, cattle, sheep, hogs &c.
to fodder them - keep 'em clean, and
milk the cows. These conditions
being complied with on his part,
I am to pay him one hundred dollars
for his year's service.

5th 6th. Very mild weather. Kill. Perry ox.7th. Wind changes to NW & blows hard.
Kill. Buck ox. Anderson & Gourrier.8th. Cold, blowing weather.9th. John came. 2 2nd Beef to M^c Miller &
brot up Herrings & salt.
