Nov. 10. Sunday. Pleasant day. Hannah return. from N. James, & Tucker cut up beef.
11. Mild Weather. Letter from Halifax.
12. Stormy. Bro't Ramis from Island.
13. Lamber & Gue came to work on the house. Rec'd. remainder of rations also 160^l apples, wine, cheese, &c.
14. Lamber & Gue at work. Rec'd. 3^l w^t. Indian Meal of Loshup Hammond. NB 10^l over w^t. Bro't fleelyards of M^r. Brammah.
15. J. M^r. Coombe arriv'd. with his Oxen. & began drawing wood. John getting up cabbages. Settled with James Suttler & paid him 20^l in full. The weather continues remarkably fine. Lamber & Gue at work.
- From 15th to Saturday 23rd. M^r. Coombe employ'd carrying out dung. Taking up front fence. Shrething & drawing wood. - M^r with Gout.
- Sunday 24th. Remain very ill with the Gout.
26. 27. M^r. Winslow ill. 28. Sent Sleight to be mended. Pleasant weather. Foddered Cattle for 4 nights past. Some snow on ground.
29. 30. Thawing weather. 30th Jeff. frig. River remains open.
- Sunday. December 1. Cold blustering day. The ice stops but the river not passable. P^r. Mary Simpson 20^l in full. Hannah Miller return. home.
2. Pleasant weather. Kill Sow of small Ramon.
3. 4. Snow. NB. From the 20th ult. to this day J. Charote has been unable to earn his victuals.
5. Clear & cold. J. Charote went off.
- From 5th to 15th. M^r with the Gout. M^r. Coombe came Friday 10th & began to work Wednesday 11th & continued till Saturday night the 14th. - 4 days. 13th travelling on the river comraens.
- To 19th. M^r. Coombe began drawing wood again. Thursday. Bowen (soldier) came Wednesday 18th.
20. M^r. Coombe Yoak? Heers. Cold.
21. Innocent Cow calv'd. Sunday 22. Bowen return. to the Garrison. 23. Bradburn began to cut wood at 1/6 of Cord.
23. George came. M^r. Coombe finish'd Wood. NB. he has haul'd 4 & 3, 7 Cords. -
27. John Charote return'd. 24th M^r. Coombe went home.
