19. - Rec^d. Quarter. Cart of port Wine from M^r. Bell.

20. Sow^d. about 1 peck Wheat & Clover on the
ground outside the Gate also a few pease.

21. Rain at night. Plenty of fish.

22. 23. Company at home. planted Potatoes
& corn.

24. Finish^d Corn - below the Wheat.

Sunday 25. At the General's. Pleasant weather.

26. Clearing for potatoes. Issued a number
of summonises as a Justice.

27. Rain in the morning. Making
fence at the Creek pasture.
Speck Cow calv. Set Salmon Net.

28. Commenced my operations as
Mil: Secretary. John Clearing for
Potatoes.

29. M^r. Anderson alter^d. Calves, lambs &c.
