At the Gov^{rs}. Lloyd in Garden. Hollowood in town with Cart. rec. 6 bus^{ls} potatoes from M^r. Miller. planted 2 bus^{ls} potatoes.

5th

Hollowood began plowing. put Melon seeds in hot bed.

6th

Sow^d 1 bus^{ls} wheat. Wash^d. 10 doz & 2 bottles.

7th

A little snow. Chilly, Pen & Ned at home.

Sunday

8th

Rec^d 2 bus^{ls} wheat from James. & by Tho^s. Hollowood p^d 9/10 bus^{ls}. A most violent storm of snow - covers the ground 3 inches.

9th

Cold uncomfortable weather. no work.

10th

Set a goose last night on 11 eggs.

11th

Sow^d 1 bus^{ls} wheat back of barn. - covered by snow 10 dozen. Chilly.

13th

Disturbingly cold. & to our utter astonishment it has been snowing again all day.

14th

Snow again in the morning & very cold all day. Making fish pole fence. M^r. W. in town.

15th

At the Governor's.

16th

Weather remains cold. Jeff. & pigs.

17th

Plowing & making fence. very cold. Shut Cow calv^d.

18th

C. Wind continues. Darius in Garden.

19th

Great Race between Chopper & Bell. Planted potatoes & Corn in Garden. Darius digging. sowing Carrots &c.

20th

Darius finish^d at 4 o'clock. Rain. Hollowood fencing &c. M^r. W. in town.

21st

Hollowood plowing for himself.

Fine day - eat 1st Salmon.
