the apple trees. Bro't up George & canoe.

24. Capt Sproule run the upper line of
my farm. very pleasant.

25. 26. Jeff & 2 pigs came in from the woods
To the Confined with the Gout.

From 1.

December.

20th.

Variable weather. Great rains —
the river rose — & the ice broke up
among the islands above. Carry^d off
considerable q^{ty} of hay — It did not
start opposite to us. Thrashing
Oats — super^d. 22 bushels ~~of~~ getting
wood &c. Gout abating.
No snow on the Ground.

25. All the Remaining Windows
miller & Loppes (agreeable to
ancient usage) kept Christmas
at Kingsclear.

No snow yet — good travel
on the Ice.

31. The Ground continues clear of
snow to the end of the month.
Nothing remarkable occurs.
