Mercure's Plan.

This begins at old mill Creek which is the Southeast boundary of the Township of Lunenburg. From thence to St. Ann's is 3 Miles. One & a half mile from mill Creek, on the opposite side of the river, is the river Nashuick, which runs about east and by north about 50 Leagues, and ends in a Lake 7 Leagues long & 2 Leagues wide. 2 Leagues from the Mouth is a small river called Parroyack
