

branch which gradually approaches Narkwiack river, and about 8 Leagues from the fork is the Portage. The land on each side this river is alternately interval & upland. The smaller branch runs nearly in the same direction as the river inclining a little to the northward, and ends 6 Leagues from the forks in a small Lake and in good Land on both sides.

Between Supac & the entrance of e Madam Keswick are 4 valuable Islands named in the plan. From Madam Keswick

Keswick to Macktoquack is 1 League. It is a river not so large as Madam Keswick, and runs in the same direction, about 2 Leagues distance from each other. About one League up this River the current is very strong, after that moderate: The Land about it of the same quality. Near its mouth there are two Islands which bear the same name as the river. On the west side of the river Macktoquack, about 4 Miles distance is Scoodewabseop, which is a small river not Navigable even
