

even for Birch Canoes. The land on both sides good and capable of good loads. Opposite to it is a small Island of about 20 acres cleared, very good. From thence to Goowac river is 5 or 6 leagues. Goowac is a small Creek with falls, not capable of navigation of any kind, but will answer for mills. Between Scood-wabcock and Goowac are 6 Islands, 4 called Bear & 2 Goowac Islands — good. — From Goowac to Nairuqua-wegack is 4 miles. This is a large River, and runs in

runs in such a direction as to come within 10 Leagues of the portage at Narkwiack, crossing the heads of Macktoquack & Madam Keswick rivers. This River is navigable for boats until you come to a branch about 25 leagues from the mouth; the lands on both sides good. From thence to Meductic falls is about 2 Leagues, and to Meductic (formerly an Indian Town) 2 Leagues more. In this space there are 2 Islands. 4 miles from the Town is Meducticneat
