27, about midnight last the enemy
blew up and left the Fort without
our ever firing a Canon at them
this Day the men were employ'd in
putting out the fires in the fort.

28 This morning the English flagg
was hoisted in the french fort
Ticonderoga, orders from the generall
that tomorrow be kept as a day of
Generall thanksgiving thro'out the
Camp.
