5th Isd. S. 47° W. — 4th Isd. 4.00 W.
— 5th Isd. is 2.00 diameter
2^d. & 3^d. Isds. about 1.00 wide, except
that 2^d. Isd. is abt. 1.60 wide to-
ward the lower end. — 1st Isd. is 1.50
by 1.50 —

1.00 on the shore (3.00)
4.00 Offset Δ left, to pt. at mouth of cove
9.00 Head of said cove Lt. 1.60
10.00 Offset down Foxpoint S. 22° W. on
whisk at 5.00, the shore on Lt. side pt.
at mouth of said cove Lt. 2.20 — at
6.00 the shore, whence a pt. Lt. Δ to-
ward said cove 1.50 — (at 6.00 the deep-
est part of cove on Fox beach rt. 3.40)
At end of 6.00, the upper end of 2^d. Great
Island at white cedar bears S. 52° W. — cut-
ting the lower end of 6th. Isd.

From white Cedar on upper end of 2^d.
Great Isd. to N. E. pt. of do 3.00, South of
which pt. a cove makes in 5.00 wide
at base, 4.00 deep, & 2.00 wide at head.

15.00 Offset down the pt. again Δ , on which
at 2.00, shore rt. 2.30, — at 6.00 rt. shore
rt. at head of a sharp cove 2.00 — at
6.75 comes to shore on Fox beach.

Whence run S. 55° W. along shore left
side of pt. on which — at 4.00 the
shore rt. 1.25 — at 5.00 X. the shore —
at 6.00 shore Lt. 1.30 — at 7.00, the
right

right side of pt. rt. 4.94 on a pt. —
at 7.40, comes to shore, whence set Δ to m.
upper end of pt., on which at $\frac{1}{2}$ dist. shore
left. 1.60

@ 16.50 to 021, whence same course continu-
ed, cut left end of 2^d. Island.

Wednesday 16th Aug^t. Proceeded to
the West shore, set monuments on the pts.
to be taken from the opposite shore —
viz N. 1 a Fallen pine, N. 2, 3, 4 & 5.
From N. 1, the 2^d. pt. on W. side of 2^d. Great
Island bears S. 50° E.
1st pt. on said Island N. 55° E.
Upper end of said Island N. 41° E.
at white Cedar

From N. 2 to N. 1 at a q^r. dist. touch on a
pt. — at $\frac{1}{2}$ dist. shore rt. 3.00, in a
cove, — and thence straight to N. 1.
From N. 3 to N. 2, at 1.00 straight, thence
turns short to rt. 2.50 — and thence
bending a little rt. to N. 2.

From N. 4 (a stake by a rock on N. 8. pt.
of a small peninsula) to N. 3, at $\frac{1}{4}$
dist. shore rt. 6.00 at the neck which
joins the peninsula (50 wide & 1.00
long) and thence almost straight to
N. 3. — The peninsula 2.00 wide
at each end, leaving bay for cove above
2.00 wide at the end at Istmus.

From N. 5 to N. 4, at 2.00 this side
of
