Lastly, from no 2. to no 1 N. 31° W. on which course, at $\frac{1}{2}$ dist. shore rt. 1.50 - at 2.00 further touches the pt. whence straight to no 1 -

Wednesday 23 Aug^r. Raining all day

Thursd. 24th Aug^r. Began the survey of the N.E. Lake ^{N. part of or gulph} Beginning at Stake no. 3, noted near the top of page 121. and making said stake @ 1st ran N. 20° 30' E. 14.00 to @ 2.

From @ 4 offset rt. $\perp$ with the former course, on which at .75 the shore at 2.00 sharp pt. to Lt. 2.75 (shore of 2^d. Id. abt. 0.50 Lt.) At 3.75 comes to the shore, whence no 2. over the left pt. of 1st Island bears N. 60° E. - and no 3 bears N. 40° 15' East. - also from @ 4 the pt. of 2^d. Island & left pt. of 3^d. Id. (or Great Island) each about .40 to rt. or left bear N. 13° 30' E.
