The amount of the fum claimed by the United States, for the damages done by the Britifh forces, far furpaffed that now claimed by the Loyalifts. And as Great Britain muft have paid for thofe damages, or have continued the war, had fhe not given up the property confifcated; it is evident, that fhe has difpofed of it for more than an adequate confideration, and is a confiderable gainer by the bargain.
