appoint You the said James Michael Treke Bulkeley to be Deputy Commisary of Accounts in the District of Nova Scotia.

You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the Duty of Deputy Commisary of Accounts as aforesaid, by doing and
performing all and all manner of Things thereunto belonging, And You are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions
from Time to Time, as You shall receive, from the Commander in Chief of His Majestys Forces in North America, the
Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majestys Treasury, the Commisary of Accounts or others Your
Superior Officer: And for your greater Encouragement well truly and diligently to discharge the Duties hereby required
of you, I hereby Order and direct the Sum of Ten Shillings sterling by the Day to be paid you, the same to commence
from the Day of the Date hereof, and to be payable for and during Your Continuance in the due Execution of the said
Office, or untill directions to the contrary shall be given.
